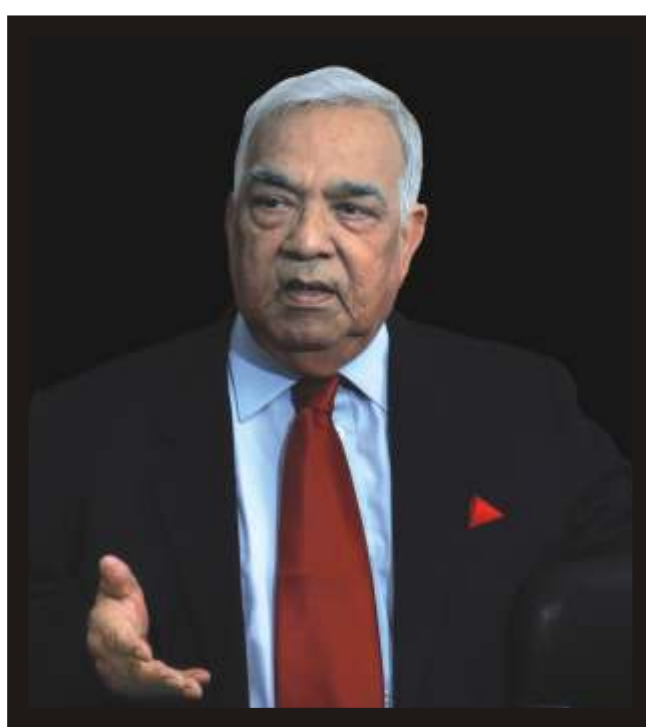
The Jaypee Palace is a pleasant drive via the Yamuna Expressway, and is also easily approachable from the Agra Railway station and the airport.
